Welcome to the 2008-2009 school year at Annunciation Catholic School Library. I look forward to seeing many of you in August during Come and Go, Meet and Greet, and the PSA Block Party. I am also anxious for you to meet or renew your acquaintance with our library assistant teacher, Sharon Menotti. We are very happy she is back at ACS this year. Sharon will be here on Wednesday mornings from 7:30 until 11:30 a.m. working with Pre-K, K, 1st, and 2nd grades. Along with story-time, we plan to do various activities relating to holidays, study projects, and/or library skills each month during the year. Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 will need a $\frac{1}{2}$ " ring binder for library worksheets and a reading log. Please send one to school by August 20th if possible.

Please notice the library rules on the back of this letter and discuss the importance of following these simple guidelines with your child. Also, each student should memorize his/her library number and remember to return books by Wednesday each week for check-in or renewal. Students who do not return books on time may not check out another book until past dues are returned. Your child may check out the following number of books weekly:

- Pre-K/Kindergarten: 1 book weekly (kept in classroom)
- First & Second grades: 1 book per week
- Third grade: 1 book per week **
- Fourth, Fifth, & Sixth grades: 2 books per week

**Students who are avid readers in the lower grades may check out more than 1 book with a note from parents.

I will be taking book requests for a fall book order. If you want your child to read certain books, series, or authors, please send a note or contact me via email. We are also planning fall and spring book fairs to raise funds for new library books. More information will be sent home about our fundraisers and volunteer sign-up in September. Your input is welcome, and I am looking forward to a great year at ACS with your children.
