Zippering backpacks

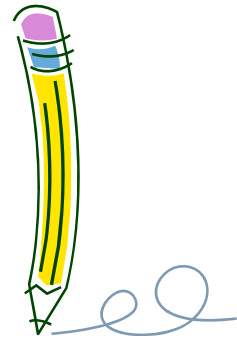
Buttoning school pants
