



Annunciation Catholic School Kindergarten Supply List 2010-2011

- 1 box of 16 count Crayola Crayons* (students really like the 24 count 'mini Twistables' if you prefer to get those, they can color neater with them)
- 1 box of Classic Washable Color Markers* that includes pink & gray
- 2 white board markers – any colors
- 1 white board eraser (girls only)
- 1 (8 or 10) pack of regular size, yellow pencils sharpened
- 1 yellow highlighter*
- 1 large eraser*
- large bottle of Elmer's Glue*
- 2 large glue sticks*
- Child size scissors*
- 3 folders of child's choice (with inside pockets) to be used as "take home folders" *
- 1 blue folder with inside pockets & brads to hold paper
- 1 red folder with inside pockets & brads to hold paper
- 1 yellow folder with inside pockets & brads to hold paper
- 1 purple folder with inside pockets & brads to hold paper
- 1 LARGE spiral notebook*
- 1 large pack of construction paper
- Your choice of any craft or collage material (pipe cleaners, buttons, sequence, popsicle sticks ect.)
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of gallon size Ziplock plastic bags (boys only)
- 2 containers of Antibacterial Wipes (Clorax & Wet Ones are popular brands, NO baby wipes)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 paint shirt
- Kindermat or washable cloth mat for rest time*
- small blanket to cover with at rest time (optional)
- backpack*
- extra change of clothes (undies, socks, shorts/pants, shirt) in labeled gallon size plastic bag

*Label with either full name or initials in permanent marker. Be sure to label individual markers and crayons, if they are not labeled I will send them back home to be labeled.

We will have snack every morning so please send a healthy snack (drink optional) everyday. Please do not send the Kool Aid plastic twist top drinks, they spray when opened and leave stains on the floor and table. I do not provide snack or drink. Snacks need to be labeled, either on the wrapper or if you choose to put it in a plastic or paper bag the bag needs to be labeled. This will help snack time go much smoother and also create less confusion with students figuring out what snack is theirs. Please DO NOT send to school in their lunch box, keep separate.

Please bring your supplies to "Come and Go," August 5th from 4 - 6 p.m. This will make the first day of school easier! Enjoy the rest of your summer and I look forward to seeing you all soon!
