4th Grade Supply List

- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 2 Roll of paper towels
- 3 Containers of disinfecting wipes
- 1 Two inch binder (for your portfolio, Pick any style you like or pick one with a clear cover and decorate it yourself.)
- 1 Two-inch binder (This binder must: have clear pockets on the front AND back, be sturdy with rings that lock strongly. Invest in a quality binder, we will wear it out! Don't decorate, organize, or label it, we'll do that together!)
- 2 Two-pocket folders with brads
- 5 Two-pocket folders, NO brads
- 2 Packages of 5-tab binder dividers
- 1 One-Subject spiral notebook
- 2 Marble composition notebooks (black and white cover-no spirals)
- 1 Plastic Rubbermaid-style shoe box (with lid)
- 4 Large, non-adhesive book covers (Keep these at home, textbooks will be sent home to cover.)
- 12 Sharpened Pencils (If you want to buy extras, please keep them at home until needed.)
- 1 Glue stick
- 2 Red pens
- 1 Bottle of white Elmer's glue
- 1 Package of markers (10 pack)
- 1 Package of colored pencils (sharpened)
- 1 Water Color Paint Set
- 1 Roll of Scotch Tape on a small dispenser (needs to fit in a pencil box, not a desktop dispenser)
- 1 Large eraser (not pencil cap style)
- Inexpensive pocket calculator
- 1 Zipper Pouch (should have holes to snap in binder)
- 2 High-lighters (need 2 different colors)
- 2 Dry-erase markers (broad-tip, any color)
- 3 Packs wide-ruled notebook paper
- Boys: 1 Box of clear sheet protectors
- Boys: 1 Package white, lined 3 x 5 index cards
- Girls: 1 Package colored, lined 3 x 5 index cards
- Girls: 1 Ream of white card stock paper
